There are also links on the desktop to various guides and area attractions.

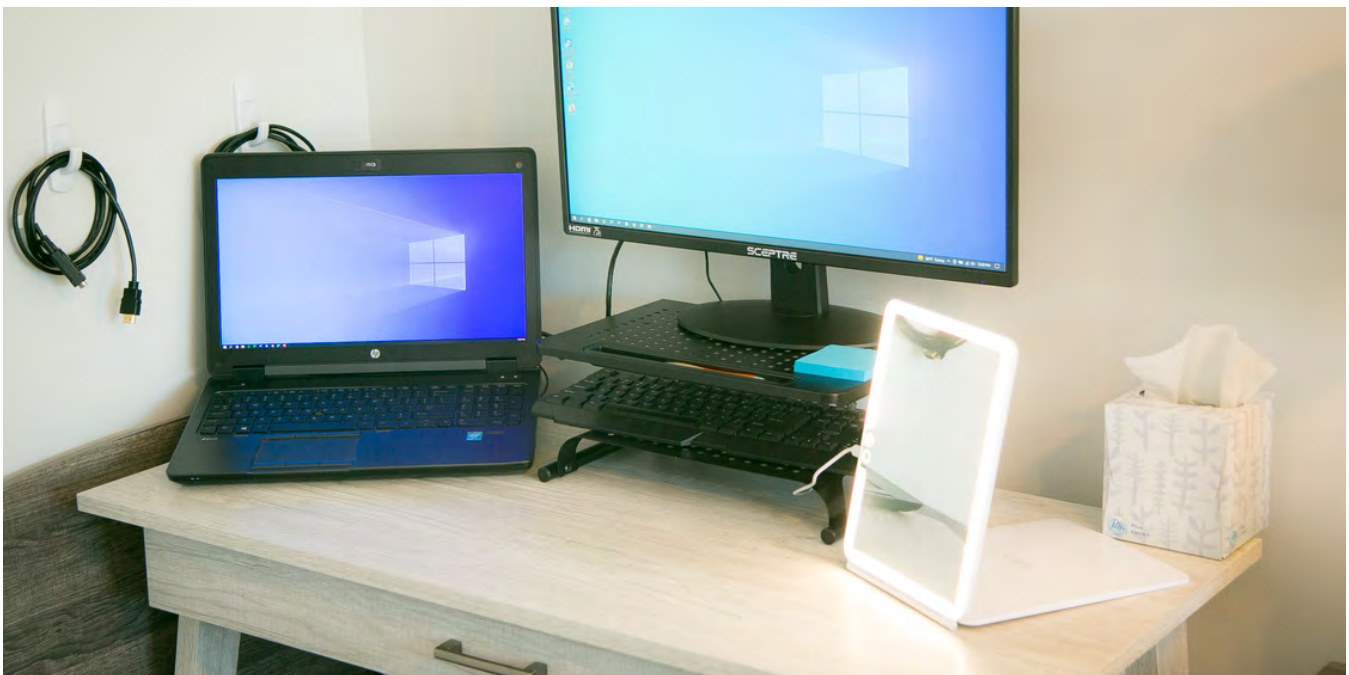
USE YOUR OWN LAPTOP!

Makeup Station

Places to Visit

BILTMORE ESTATE

Visit Biltmore, America's Largest Home, built by George Vanderbilt. Explore the 8000-acre estate in the Blue Ridge Mountains of Asheville, NC.

THE OMNI GROVE PARK INN

An amazing resort with an equally amazing view. Visit the spa, restaurants, golf course, and piano bar. Fantastic buffet dinner on Fri and Sat evenings.

RIVER ARTS DISTRICT

The River Arts District is a creative hub along the French Broad River. Former warehouses and mills now contain glassblowing, potter, and artisan studios.

NORTH CAROLINA ARBORETUM

Wonderful gardens, walking paths, and frequent events and activities year round.

MOUNT MITCHELL

Mount Mitchell's summit (elevation 6,684 feet), is the highest point east of the Mississippi River. Drive to the top and visit/hike the summit!

DUPONT STATE FOREST

DuPont State Recreational Forest is an outdoor lover's dream with many waterfalls and 86 miles of trails on protected 10,000 acres.

PISGAH NATIONAL FOREST

The Pisgah National Forest is a land of mile-high peaks, cascading waterfalls, and heavily forested slopes. Comprised of over 500,000 acres, the Pisgah is primarily a hardwood forest with whitewater rivers, waterfalls and hundreds of miles of trails.

ASHEVILLE

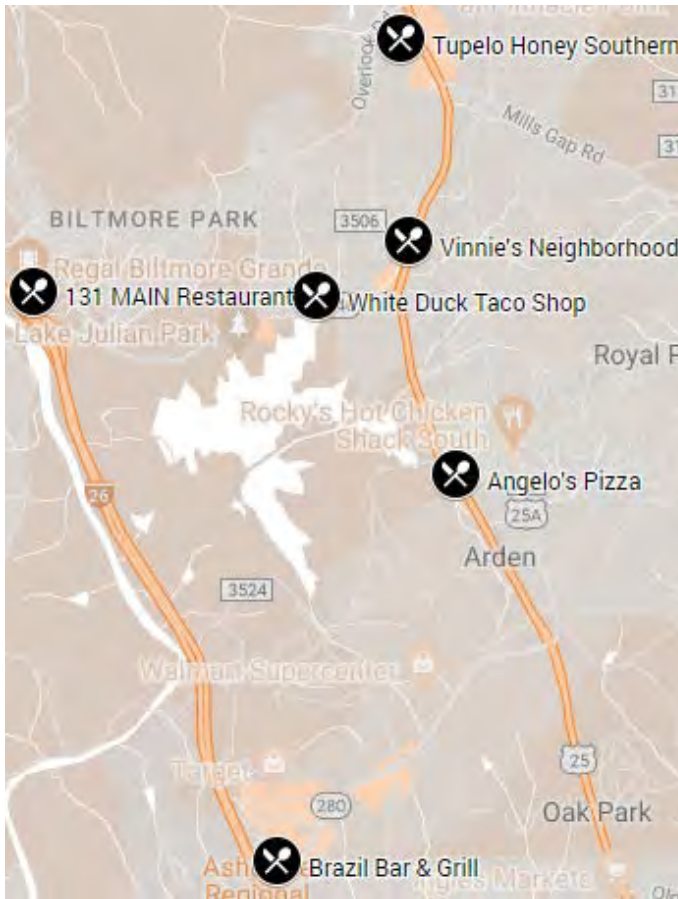

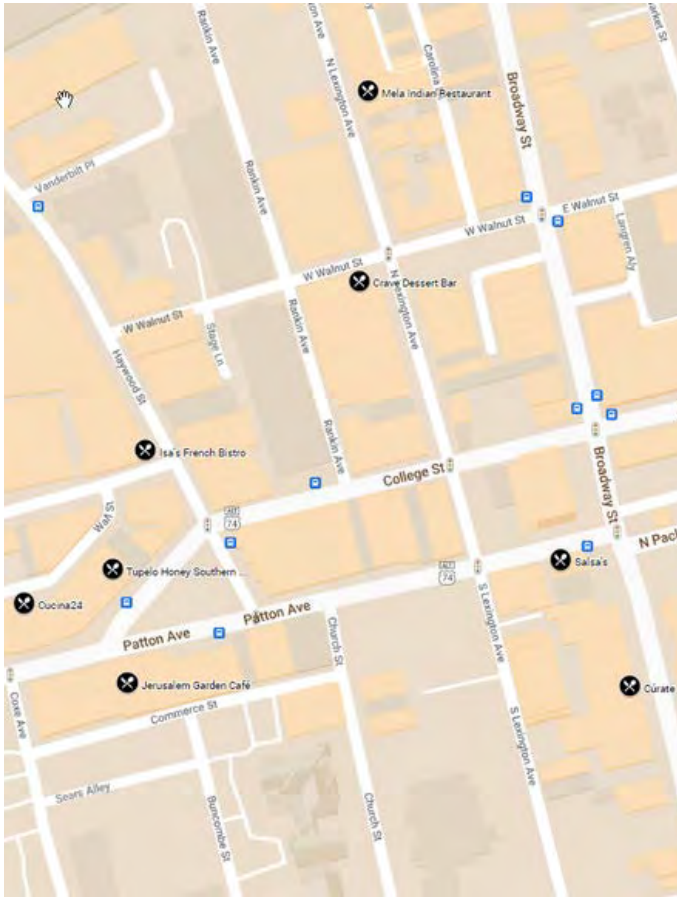
